I am requesting funding for the Pre-adjusdicated Supportive Services (DC-PASS). The entity to receive funding is Douglas County Nebraska. Douglas County is requesting funds to expand the variety and type of Stability Services available to Douglas County pre-adjudicated youth. Specifically, this would allow higher-risk pre-adjudicated youth to be appropriately supervised in the community in lieu of detention by creating a supervision plan that provides wrap-around services and supports for both the youth and their family. Through the expansion of services available to this population, we will be able to help prevent youth from progressing deeper into the juvenile and adult criminal justice systems and also promoting community safety. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will help prevent youth crime
